RE: Banned Athletic Substances

Dear Douglas Laboratories Customer:

The presence of substances in dietary supplements that are banned by various athletic organizations around the world has become an increasing concern for athletes. The World Anti-Doping Agency has been at the forefront of preventing doping in athletics in general with specific attention to the Olympics. The World Anti-Doping Agency publishes an annual list of prohibited substances. We have reviewed this list, and based on the 2011 Prohibited List of the World Anti-Doping Code, Douglas Laboratories does not handle any of the compounds on this list at our facility where we manufacture tablets, capsules and powders. This is further confirmed by the fact that Douglas Laboratories is registered as NSF GMP for Sport<sup>TM</sup>, which prevents us from manufacturing products that contain ingredients on the WADA list.
